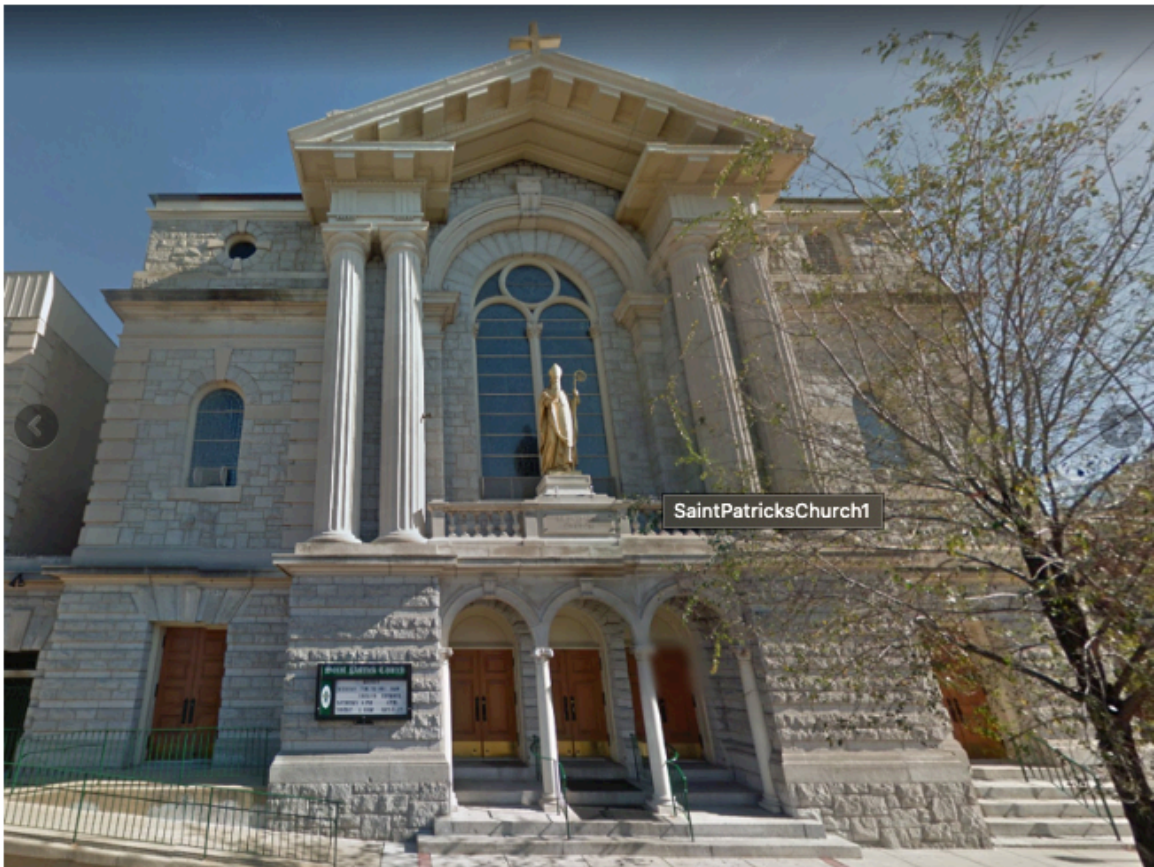



Amen.

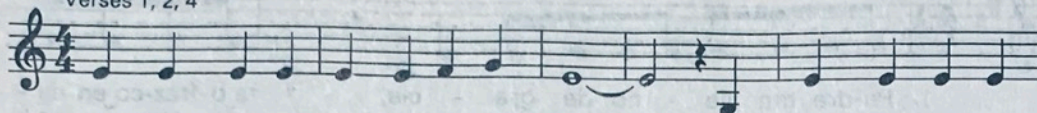
