

## Health Screening 1 - 3 PM Examen de Salud 1 - 3 PM

All except Vision Screening will be in School Building. Vision Screening in the kitchen as you exit the lower Church/Parish hall. You can get free Vision Insurance to go to an eye doctor and get free eyeglasses.

Todos, excepto el examen de la vista, se realizarán en el edificio escolar. Examen de la vista en la cocina al salir del salón parroquial/iglesia inferior. Puede obtener un seguro de visión gratuito para ir a un oftalmólogo y obtener anteojos gratis.

In the school / En la escuela:

First floor. Blood Pressure, blood sugar, height and weight, doctors, immunization vouchers, physical therapy, dentist, other information from Catholic Social Services.

Primer piso. Presión arterial, azúcar en la sangre, altura y peso, médicos, comprobantes de vacunación, fisioterapia, dentista, otra información de Servicios Sociales Católicos.

Second floor: Immigration Lawyer and Mexican Consulate representative.

Segundo piso: Abogada de Inmigración y representante del Consulado de México.

## Vision Foundation Instructions

1. At the monthly Health Screening, a volunteer will check your vision. If you need glasses, we will ask you to fill in your information on a form. Please write in your birthday, address and phone number carefully.
2. Then, St. Patrick's Health Screening Program will submit your information to the Vision Foundation.
3. After a week or so you will receive a call from the parish office mail to come in and pick up a form from the Vision Foundation. That form notifies you that you are eligible for VBA insurance (for 60 days) to get a free eye exam and glasses from a VBA participating eye doctor.
4. You may find eligible eye doctors on line at: <https://online.visionbenefits.com/Search/default.aspx> Use the Zip Code search for your address. Then select and call a doctor. Or, call any eye doctor and ask if they accept VBA insurance. Then make an appointment.
5. When you go to the doctor, just tell them you are covered by VBA. They can confirm online. Please bring some form of identification.
6. After the exam, someone will help you select from the standard frames. NOTE: VBA does not cover special frames or extra lense treatments like transition or tinted lenses. You will have to pay the added charge for such.
